After preparing and cooking the meal together, participants of Community Kitchens then sit down and share the meal, or if there is any leftover food cooked in the Kitchen this can be taken home to families.

Participants can run the group together, and all be involved in planning, organising, cooking and most importantly eating! All participants can have an equal say in how the Kitchen operates. There is also usually 1-2

'group leaders', also participants, who are there to help the group run smoothly.
